

Request for Reasons for Decision Mental Health Act 2014 (WA)

The Mental Health Act 2014 (the Act) provides that a party may request the Tribunal to provide reasons for a Tribunal decision in a proceeding. The Tribunal will also consider a request for reasons made on behalf of a party by the party's representative (legal practitioner, mental health advocate, or nominated person).

Please note that section 468 provides that it is an offence to publish certain information about a proceeding of the Mental Health Tribunal. Section 576 provides that it is an offence to disclose certain personal information. Penalties apply.
