

My Mental Health Tribunal hearing is over and I am still an involuntary patient. What happens next?

- You will receive a Notice of Decision in the next few days. This is the written version of the Tribunal's decision today.
- You may apply to the State Administrative
 Tribunal for a review of the Tribunal's
 decision. This must be done within 28
 days of the day the Tribunal gives you the
 Notice of Decision.
- If you want the Tribunal's reasons for today's decision, write to the Tribunal within 28 days to ask for this to be sent to you.
- If you want to speak to an advocate about today's decision, call the Mental Health Advocacy Service on 6234 6300.
- If you want to speak to a lawyer about today's decision, call the Mental Health Law Centre on 9328 8012.
- If you are still an involuntary patient in 3 months, the Tribunal will review your order again.
